Applications are sought from outstanding primary-school-focussed and multi-skilled music educators who have a detailed knowledge of and classroom experience in Kodaly and Orff methodologies. Outstanding choral direction skills are essential.

The Co-ordinator oversees the entire Junior School Music Program which includes both instrumental and classroom music. As well as the administration of the music program, the successful applicant will teach class music from Years 3-6 and train and conduct choirs.

Key Requirements of the Role are:

- A proven history of delivering sound curriculum designed to engage and challenge students on an individual level;
- Strong vocal and choral conducting skills;
- An understanding of music and IT in the classroom;
- A willingness and desire to grow with the program;
- An enthusiastic and positive approach towards teaching boys;
- Competent piano skills.

Applicants must be able to demonstrate initiative in line with the Music School philosophy, have a strong passion for music and the performing arts, and have the ability to work effectively as a team member.
