

Musical Instrument Loan and Hire 2019

The following instruments are available for loan and hire through Brighton Grammar School:

flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, saxophone, trumpet, French horn, trombone, euphonium, tuba, violin, viola, cello, double bass.

There is a fee charged to piano and percussion students to cover the purchase and maintenance of School instruments. Guitars are not available for hire through the School.

The hire fees for 2019 are as follows:

Instrument	Fee per semester	Fee per year
Orchestral and band instruments	\$105.00	\$210.00
Piano and percussion <i>(this covers the use and maintenance of School instruments)</i>	\$50.00	\$100.00

Please note that hire fees are only charged for Private/Paired Lessons – they do not apply for students in the Junior School Strings Program (Years 3–5), the Junior School Band Program (Years 5–6) or the Beginner Instrumental Program (Year 7), or if the student is the holder of a Music Bursary or Music Scholarship. If your son is in one of these programs, although there is no fee for hiring the instrument, you will still need to complete your acceptance of the terms and conditions outlined below.

Instrument Loan and Hire Terms and Conditions

1. Instrument loan and hire from BGS is subject to availability.
2. After hiring an instrument for one year from BGS, students taking Private Lessons are encouraged to purchase their own instrument.
3. Instruments can only be hired from BGS for a maximum of two years while taking Private Lessons. Exceptions may be made for very expensive instruments such as oboe, French horn, euphonium, double bass or tuba.
4. Hire fees will be included on your son's account in Semester 1 and Semester 2.
5. Students are responsible for the care and safety of their School-owned instrument.
6. School-owned instruments are not to be loaned to others.
7. Parents must reimburse the School for the replacement cost of any School-owned instrument that is lost or stolen. Parents are encouraged to include the School-owned instrument on their insurance.
8. Instruments must be stored in the storage areas as directed by the Music staff. If instruments are damaged in any location other than the storage area, parents are liable for all repair or replacement costs.

By completing the approval process through Consent2Go, you are providing your acceptance of the above Terms and Conditions, and authorisation for the hire fee to be charged to your son's School account (if applicable).
