

## Private Music Tuition 2020

**Individual tuition is available on the following instruments:**

Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, Bassoon, Saxophone, Trumpet, French horn, Trombone, Euphonium, Tuba, Classical guitar, Bass guitar, Violin, Viola, Cello, Double bass, Percussion, Piano, Voice

Individual music lessons are offered at the following rates:

*Note: Parental attendance is compulsory for students in Prep and for the first term of lessons in Years 1 and 2*

Each student will be issued with an exercise book and a Music Record Book. The exercise book will contain information regarding the lesson and the focus for the week's home practice. The student should record his weekly practice in the exercise book, with parents viewing and signing it. The Music Record Book will remain at School as a record of lessons.

Brighton Grammar School is happy to facilitate students to undertake AMEB exams. Parents will receive paperwork from their son's instrumental teacher if they feel the exam will be of benefit to the student's progress.

**Lower Primary Students**

Once an enrolment form has been submitted, the specific instrumental teacher, in association with the relevant class teacher, will assess the student on whether he is ready for instrumental lessons. At such a young age, it is important for the parent to support his practice at home, as well as to develop clear communication lines with the teacher.

Note: If your son is in Prep, a parent will be required to be present at all instrumental lessons.

If your son is in Years 1 or 2, a parent will be required to be present at all instrumental lessons during the first term of tuition. After the first term of lessons, and at the instrumental teacher's discretion, boys can attend their lessons independently.

### Ensembles

As students become more proficient, they are required to participate in appropriate School ensembles as advised by the Music staff. Please see below for the 2019 rehearsal schedule.

### Terms and Conditions

- Over the course of the academic year, 28 lessons will be scheduled. Please note that Year 12 students are billed for 21 lessons over the course of the academic year.
- It is the responsibility of the student to notify his Music teacher and/or the Music office at least 24 hours in advance** of upcoming events that will prevent him from attending his lesson or rehearsal (phone (03) 8591 2258 or [music@brightongrammar.vic.edu.au](mailto:music@brightongrammar.vic.edu.au)). Students will be charged for unnotified absences.
- Lessons are arranged on a rotating timetable during the school day.** It may not be feasible to meet special requests for individual timetabling below Year 10.
- Music tuition charges will be included on your fee account for Semesters 1 and 2.
- The Music Record Book cost will be included on your fee account once per year. Replacement books will also be charged to this account.
- Parents will receive a weekly email with the lesson time for the following week. Students can also check the timetables posted on notice boards in the Music School, Urwin Centre and Junior School each week to ensure they are aware of their lesson times.
- The purchase of music books, reeds and other sundries are to be arranged by parents, preferably through suppliers recommended by the instrumental teacher or the Music Department.
- Notice to discontinue private music lessons must be given in writing (email is acceptable) and addressed to the Director of Music. Lessons can only be discontinued at the end of a term, and one full term's notice must be given.**
- Parents/Guardians will be given at least one term's notice of any forthcoming increase in tuition fees.
- Students are expected to practise for the length of time indicated by their teacher. The attention and cooperation of parents in this matter is requested to ensure continual development on the chosen instrument.
