### Commitments during school term:

The Choral Scholars rehearse on Mondays from 4.00pm to 4.45pm (Trebles/Sopranos and Altos only), and on Wednesdays from 7.00pm to 8.30pm (Full Choir).

The regular pattern of Sunday morning rehearsal and performance commitments, during term time, is a Choral Eucharist at 10.00am with a rehearsal from 8.50am.

The regular pattern of Sunday afternoon/evening rehearsal and performance commitments, during term time, is a Sunday evening choral service at 6.00pm with a rehearsal from 5.00pm on the second and fourth Sunday evenings of the month, and a rehearsal from 12.00pm until 2.00pm on the third Sunday.

During term time, the Choral Scholars are not required on public-holiday long weekends and mid-term break weekends.

The only out-of-school term commitments are for rehearsals and services during Holy Week and Easter, and from Advent Sunday up to and including Christmas Eve (with the immensely popular Festival of Nine Lessons and Carols presented at St Andrew's annually for over half a century) and Christmas Day.
