Children have a strong sense of identity

- **O1.1** Children feel safe, secure, and supported
- **O1.2** Children develop their emerging autonomy, inter-dependence, resilience and sense of agency
- **O1.3** Children develop knowledgeable and confident self identities
- **O1.4** Children learn to interact in relation to others with care, empathy and respect

Children are connected with and contribute to their world

- **O2.1** Children develop a sense of belonging to groups and communities and an understanding of the reciprocal rights and responsibilities necessary for active community participation
- **O2.2** Children respond to diversity with respect
- **O2.3** Children become aware of fairness
- **O2.4** Children become socially responsible and show respect for the environment

Children have a strong sense of wellbeing

- O3.1 Children become strong in their social and emotional wellbeing

Children are confident and involved learners
