Term 2

Term 2 Fees

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Private lessons

We are delighted to offer students a 9 week private lessons program in Term 2. This is an ideal program for those who want extra support with their swimming as the lessons are tailored for the individual student. Classes run from Tuesday 25 April - Friday 24 June, with lessons available from 5.00pm - 6.00pm. Private lessons run on a term schedule so the cost for the 9 week program is \$675, due prior to the first lesson. Private lessons are allocated on a first-serve basis, so please email bgsplus@brightongrammar.vic.edu.au to secure your spot for Term 2.

Make-up lessons

We understand that sometimes your child will miss a lesson due to illness. If this happens, you may qualify for a make-up lesson. Please note the following:

- Notice must be given at least 3 hours prior to the scheduled class time, once *BGS+* Swim has been notified a make-up lesson will be allocated to your child's account.
- Make-up lessons can be booked through our online customer portal, using your unique log-in details.
- Make-up lessons cannot be exchanged for cash refunds or future credits
