

This Scholarship is available to boys entering from Year 9 in 2026.

A copy of the applicant's most recent school report and most recent NAPLAN results are required at the time of application.

The Sliding Doors Scholarship will be awarded to a boy who has a demonstrated interest in leadership pursuits and creating a positive impact in their community.

The successful applicant must be able to demonstrate that he would benefit from the opportunities that a Brighton Grammar School education would present and who in normal circumstances would not have the opportunity to attend the School.

The Scholarship will cover the majority of tuition fees, not incidental expenses incurred by the Scholarship holder and his family from time to time. The Scholarship will also cover any curriculum based expenses e.g., compulsory School camps and excursions. Expenses not covered include and are not limited to uniform, textbooks, computer and non-compulsory excursions and camps.

The awarding of this scholarship will be determined by the following process:

- Completion of the Brighton Grammar School application form
- Submission of a written piece of work outlining the applicant's interest in a Brighton Grammar School education and how this will assist them to further their talents and interests
- The completion of a financial disclosure document of both parents or guardians (at the shortlist stage)
- Teacher recommendations or feedback are welcomed

Selected applicants will be invited to an interview. Not all applicants will be interviewed. All candidates will be notified of the outcome of their application.
